Mine for some reason was TA. When, some time later, we learned about ham call signs and how they were constructed, I changed mine to OL2TA. The OL stood for "Ohne Lizens" (German for "without license") and the "2" indicated 2m band. The OL prefix has never been used until recently. It is between OK, Czech Republic and ON, Belgium: OL is now used by the former. By the way, DL2TA, who was established at the time, received QSLs for QSOs I conducted. We met each other in person later and had a good laugh about it. This certainly has been a long winter and as usual with the Ohio spring, one day it's warm and the next day cold again. We will take a break and spend a few days with our daughter in California.
