Cooperative Agreement Between Quarter Century Wireless Association, Inc. and The American Radio Relay League, Inc.

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to formalize a cooperative agreement between the Quarter Century Wireless Association, Inc. (hereafter "Q.C.W.A.") and the American Radio Relay League, Inc. including its Canadian Division, the Canadian Radio Relay League. Inc. (hereafter, jointly, "the League").

2. RECOGNITION

- A. The Q.C.W.A. recognizes the League as the one bi-national organization which represents overall the interests of all U.S. and Canadian Amateurs.
- B. The League recognizes the Q.C.W.A. as an independent international organization of Amateur Radio operators who were first licensed at least a quarter of a century ago and who can provide a vast reservoir of knowledge and experience for the benefit of all radio amateurs.

3. EXTENT OF COOPERATION

- A. Q.C.W.A., with its headquarters in Irving, Texas, and the League, with headquarters in Newington, Connecticut, and London, Ontario, will maintain continuing liaison and will provide mutual support in the general protection, promotion and advancement of the Amateur Radio Service.
- B. Upon request from Q.C.W.A. Headquarters, the League will provide designated Q.C.W.A. Chapters with information mailings normally provided ARRL/CRRL affiliated clubs.
 - C. Other areas of mutual cooperation may be developed as appropriate.

4. TERMINATION

This cooperative agreement may be terminated at any time by vote of the Board of Directors of either organization and upon appropriate notification to the headquarters of the other organization.
